## Seeds of Hope for a Better Future

2025 Competition Rules and Guidelines

- 1. The competition is open to all participating countries with UNESCO ASPnet National Coordinators.
- 2. Primary, Secondary, Tertiary and any collaborative working between these sectors can apply.
- 3. All entries must complete the **2025 Seeds of Hope for a Better Future Competition Entry Form** and provide evidence of working drafts to show how the ideas have been/will be developed from 'Idea to Reality'.
- 4. There must be one designated point of contact for each application.
- 5. Entries must reach the UNESCO ASPnet National Coordinators in participating countries no later than 1 July 2025.
- 6. ASPnet National Coordinators are responsible for checking eligibility and forwarding these to the Competition Panel of Judges,
- 7. The Panel of Judges will evaluate the artworks and select the overall winners and any candidates that merit Special Artists Prizes.
- 8. Judges will give priority to artistic endeavours with evidence of the following:
  - Imaginative, engaging, high quality art works developed for the benefit of others
  - Use of existing scientific studies/materials from seed banks
  - Reflect the ethos of the Arts and Culture for Peace Initiative of partnership working ie young people, educators, artists, scientists coming together to develop impactful outcomes
  - Effectively appeal to local communities and successfully raise local awareness of the impact of climate change on seed biodiversity
  - Promoting the UNESCO ASPnet Action Areas peace, sustainability and intercultural learning and heritage.
- 9. The Judges' decisions are final.
